



Adventurer (Warrior + Carer)	Thinker	Thinker	Artist or Crusader
Artist (Carer + Thinker)	Warrior	Warrior	Adventurer or Crusader
Crusader (Thinker + Warrior)	Carer	Carer	Artist or Adventurer
